to write down everything in gradation.1






The pen wrote down who your family will be, including your ethnicity and even your nationality.

Allah (swt) told the pen to write down our rizq, for us to learn and to go out and earn.⁷




Allah (swt) is the Originator, His abilities no one can ever match, as it is only He, who has made everything from scratch!

All Allah (swt) had to say was "Kun" and fa yakun.9







Abdullah b. 'Amr b. al-'As (ra) reported: I heard Allah's Messenger (saw) as saying: Allah ordained the measures (of quality) of the creation fifty thousand years before He created the heavens and the earth, as His Throne was upon water. (Sahih Muslim 2653b, Book 46, Hadith 27)

"Say (O'Muhammad (saw): 'Do you verily disbelieve in Him who created the earth in two days and you set up rivals (in worship) with Him? That is the Lord of all that exists. He placed therein (earth) firm mountains from above it, and He blessed it, and measured therein its sustenance (for its dwellers) in four days equal (i.e. all these four 'days' were equal in length of time) for all those who ask (about its creation). Then He Istawa ila the heaven when it was smoke, and said to it and to the earth: "Come both of you willingly or unwillingly." They both said: "We come willingly." Then He finished them (as) seven heavens in two days and He made in each heaven its affair. And we adorned the nearest (lowest) heaven with lamps (stars) to be an adornment as well as to guard (from such devils by using them as missiles against the devils). Such is the decree of the Almighty, the Knower." (Quran 41:9-12). (Tafsir Ibn Kathir, Abridge, Volume 1)

- "Did you not realize that the purity of Allah is proclaimed by all those in the heavens and the earth, and by the birds with their wings spread out? Everyone knows one's own (way of) praying (to Allah) and one's own (way of) proclaiming Allah's purity and Allah knows well what they do." (Quran 24:41)
- "There is no creature on earth whose sustenance is not undertaken by Allah. He knows its permanent and its temporary place. Everything is in a clear book." (Quran 11:6)
- "O messengers, eat from the good things, and act righteously. Of whatever you do, I am fully aware." (Quran 23:51)
- "And Allah has made the earth for you as a carpet (spread out), That ye may go about therein, in spacious roads." (Quran 71:19-20)

- "Nay, you prefer the life of this world, Although the Hereafter is better and more lasting." (Quran 87:16-17)
- The Messenger of Allah (saw) took me by the shoulder and said, "Be in this world as though you were a stranger or a wayfarer." And Ibn Umar (ra) used to say, "In the evening do not expect (to live until) the morning, and in the morning do not expect (to live until) the evening. Take (advantage of) your health before times of sickness, and (take advantage of) your life before your death." (Sahih Al-Bukhari 6416, Book 81, Hadith 5)
- This Surah is a matchless specimen of comprehensiveness and brevity. A whole world of meaning has been compressed into its few brief words, which is too vast in content to be fully expressed even in a book. In it, in a clear and plain way it has been stated what is the way to true success for man and what is the way to ruin and destruction for him. Imam Shafi has very rightly said that if the people only considered this Surah well, it alone would suffice them for their quidance. How important this Surah was in the sight of the Companions can be judged from the tradition cited from Hadrat Abdullah bin Hisn ad-Darimi Abu Madinah, according to which whenever any two of them met they would not part company until they had recited Surah Al-Asr to each other. (Tabarani)

In this Surah an oath has been sworn by the Time to impress the point that man is in sheer loss and only those people are an exception from the loss who are characterized by four qualities: (1) Faith, (2) righteous deeds, (3) exhorting one another to Truth, and (4) exhorting one another to patience. (Quran, 103: 1-3)

Al-'Asr is the time in which the movements of the Children of Adam occur, whether good or evil. Malik narrated from Zayd bin Aslam that he said, "It is the evening." However, the first view is the popular opinion. Thus, Allah swears by this, that man is in Khusr, which means in loss and destruction. إِذَّ النَّبِينَ (Except those who believe and do righteous good deeds) آمَنُوا وَعَمِلُوا الصَّالِحَاتِ

So Allah makes an exception, among the species of man being in loss, for those who believe in their hearts and work righteous deeds with their limbs.) المواقرة المواقرق المواقرة المو truth,) This is to perform acts of obedience and avoid the forbidden things.) آثرَ استَوْل بِــــالصَّنْدِرِ And recommend one another to patience.) meaning, with the plots, the evils, and the harms of those who harm people due to their commanding them to do good and forbidding them from evil. (Tafsir Ibn Kathir, Abridged Volume 10)
