Lut (as) felt defeated and the Angels then comforted. They explained their purpose, which was to remove this burden.






The moral of this story is to be mindful of one's passions and not engage in immoral actions.





- 6. The 3 Angels disguised as men that were visiting Ibrahim(as) with the glad tidings of Isaac (as) to Sarah (ra) left Ibrahim(as) and came to visit Lut (as).
- 7. Lut (as) daughter saw the men and was stunned by their beauty. She requested for the guests to wait there and not leave as she was afraid of the corruption that may ensue if other men saw them.

SYNOPSIS OF STORY

- **8.** Lut (as) was informed of the guests and he became distressed and wanted to convince the guests not to take up residence in his town but also demonstrate the hospitality extended to guests.
- **9.** Lut (as) wife informed the community of the guests and a mob of people came to engage in indecency. He pleaded with them to leave his guests alone and to engage in what is permissible with their wives.
- **10.** The people roared with laughter at his sermon and blinded by passion broke down the door and Lut (as) stood powerless.
- 11. Seeing Lut (as) so distressed the guests informed him that they were indeed angels and that Allah (swt) had decreed that the city of Sadum should perish.
