# Dear Parents

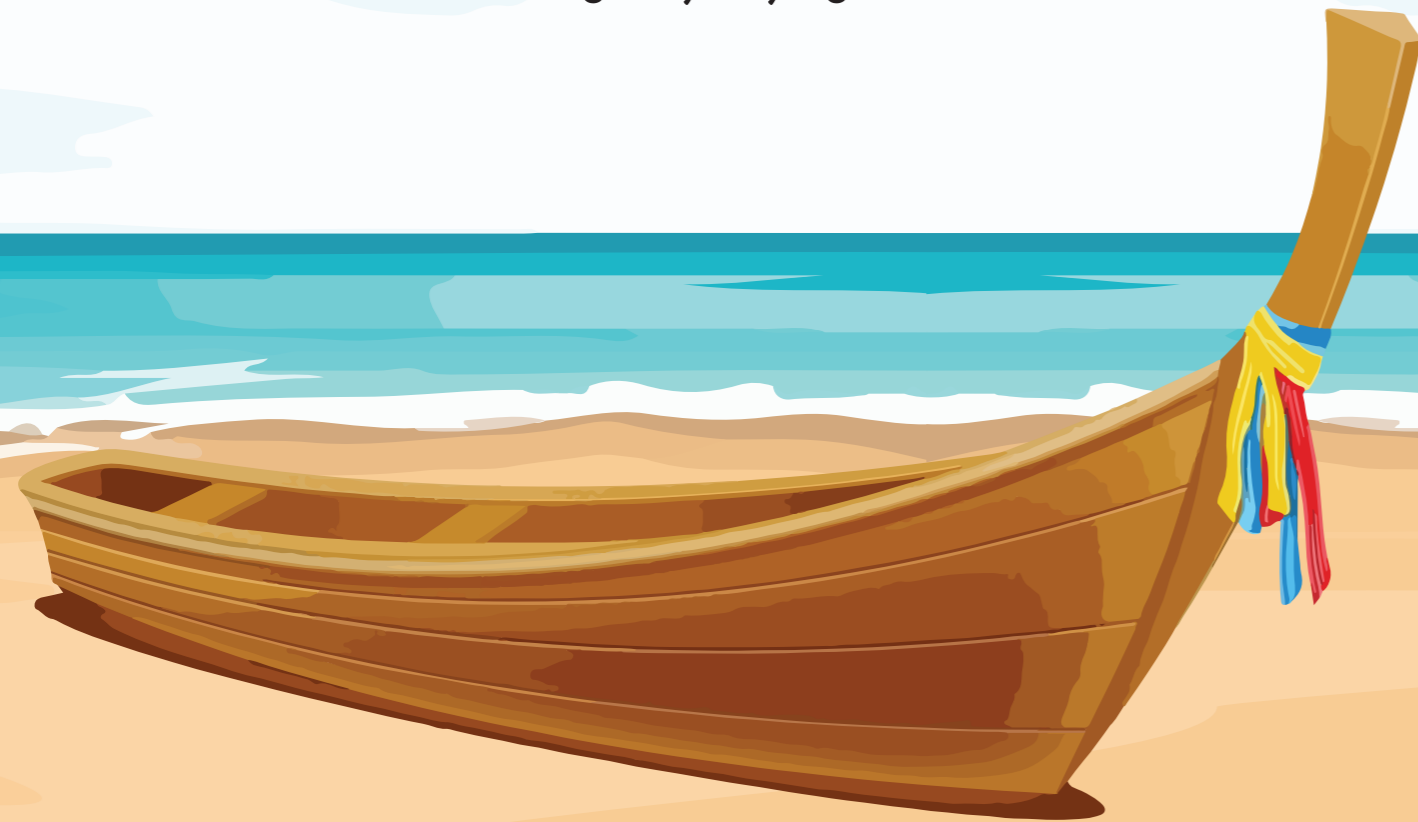
The purpose of this book is as follows:

Looking at all this Allah (swt) became quite displeased.



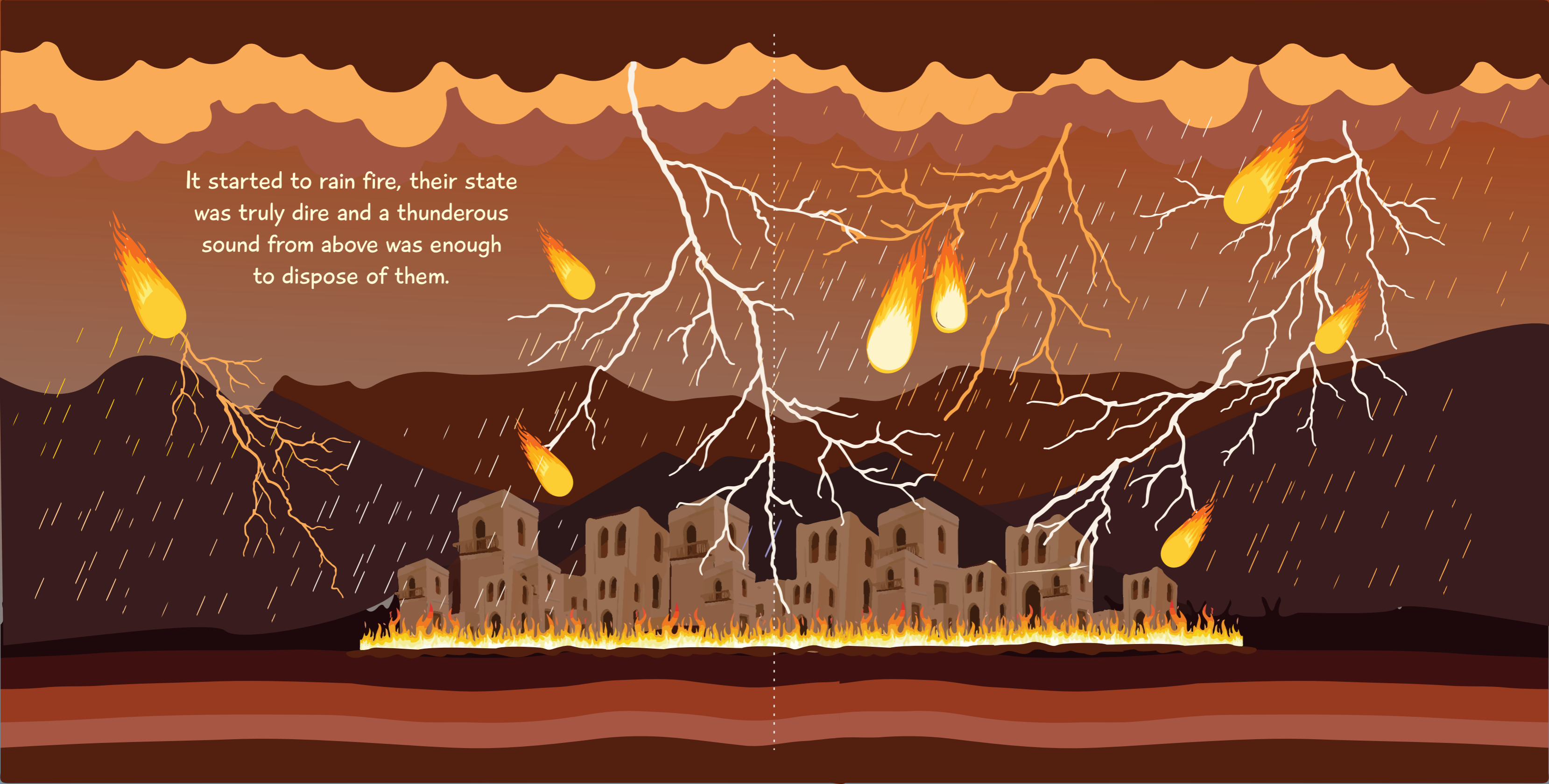
They accused him of preaching for
