without any distractions.



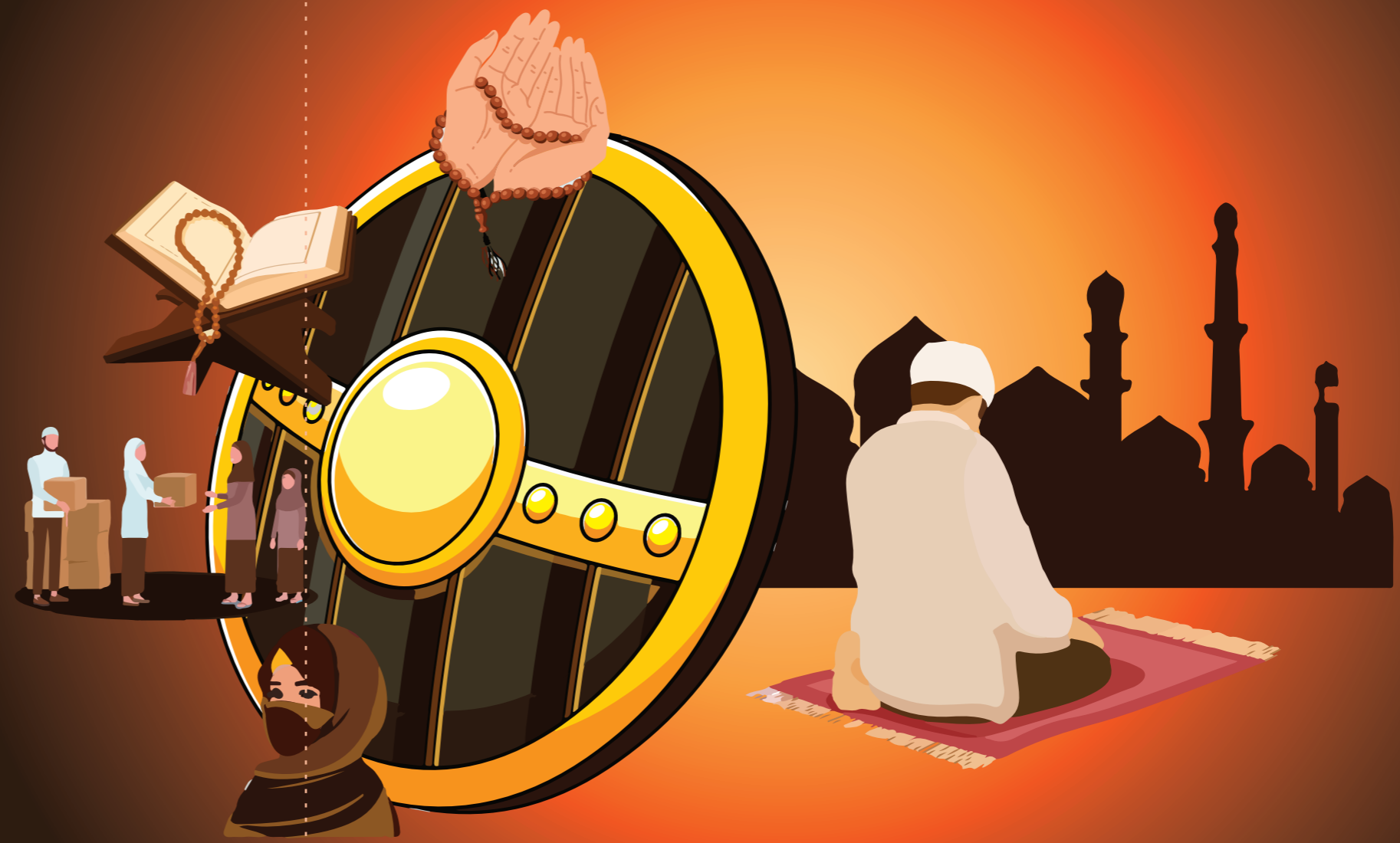
He was alert and weary, knowing that

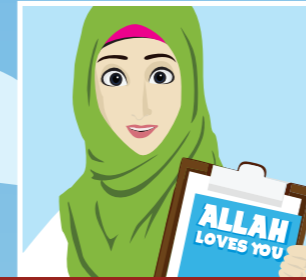
