To become aware of the signs and examples left behind to teach us lesson, repent and come back to our Maker, the one we all will be returning to.


I pray this book brings us and our families closer together and that you both are able to see the love and mercy of Allah (swt) and find contentment in your heart over all your affairs. Ameen.

They prayed for Yunus (as) to return so they may truly learn.






They drew lots to see, who would have to jump sea. Not once, not twice but thrice, Yunus (as) name was clear and he knew it was time to jump with no fear.




