Three Angels arrived saying no longer shall you be deprived.






Sarah (ra) was preparing a calf and she started to laugh.

She said we are now retired but children are what we have always admired.










He wanted his son to marry and advised him of a potential suitor. Is hac (as) trusted his father and said you can be my recruiter.

Lastly, to nurture family relations as that is the strongest foundation.






