Let us begin by saying Bismillah!







on the one with true credence.


Hizqeel (as) returned to Allah and Shaytan went into full gear. His mission was clear, steer everyone to a fate so very drear.









King Talut was also appointed hoping this time

Only a few had listened, passing the test when told to rest. The few that remained marched forward as per Allah's (swt) orders.








